

- Report <u>Still In Every Class In Every School</u>: A final report on the Second National Climate Survey on Homophobia, Biphobia, and Transphobia in Canadian Schools.
- **Tip Sheet** <u>Childinü Oxford Pride Educator Tip Sheet</u>: A brief reference guide aimed specifically at Early Learning professionals for how to create an inclusive space and basic concepts.
- **Videos** <u>PRIDE Understanding</u>: Child-friendly videos on a variety of topics like acceptance and understanding, transgender identity, same-sex marriage, how to be an ally, and the importance of pronouns.

- Resource Guide <u>Create Inclusive Schools with Egale Canada</u>: Includes guides on concepts like human identity, pronoun usage guide, affirming language, 2SLGBTQI terms and concepts, days of significance, how to make your bathrooms inclusive, how to support a gender diverse child, inclusive posters, additional training opportunities and more.
- Pedagogical Guide & Videos <u>Hi Sam: Sensitizing Youth Through Play</u>: Designed to help educators to introduce concepts and address issues surrounding gender identity, roles, stereotypes, and norms in elementary schools.
- Discussion Guide <u>Gender Doesn't Limit You; A Research-Based Anti-Bullying Program for the Early Grades</u>: Six scenarios tackling bullying among school-age children. Topics include peer exclusion, role exclusion, teasing about gender activities, biased judgments, gendered beliefs and highlighting gender.

- Resource Guide <u>Building Bridges: 2SLBTQI & Affirming Faith Workbooks</u>: Offers foundational concepts, guiding principles and promising practices to support anyone seeking to create more inclusive programming and services. Includes Indigenous Faith, Christianity, Hinduism, Islam, Judaism and Sikhism.
- Video Two Spirits, One Voice: A four-minute video introduction of Two-Spirit identities.
- Article <u>Coming Out; Living Authentically as Black LGBTQ People</u>: An intersectional resource guide about the lived experience of coming out as LGBTQ as a Black person, including reactions by family, multi-culturalism and code-switching, religion and faith, film and television, etc.
